Thank you for your question.

We are asking all individuals or groups wishing distribute materials at our schools to comply with the reasonable time, manner and place rules described in district policy KHC-R. <https://www.dcsdk12.org/cs/groups/public/@weblegal/documents/webcontent/dcs668091.pdf>

Basically, as long as the distribution is not disruptive to the school's operations, does not occur during instructional time, any discarded materials are collected by the distributor, and the materials include the required disclaimer (so there is no question that the school or district are not using school resources for campaign purposes in accordance with the law), anyone should be able to work out a mutually-agreeable arrangement with the school's leadership to distribute materials.
